Diagnostic data generated by the WPT enables retro and ongoing commissioning to save energy and reduce maintenance costs. It is estimated that over 70% of buildings in North America still have pneumatic thermostats and can benefit from the WPT system. Introduced in 2008, the WPT has been deployed in over 300 sites, including the Architect of the Capitol, GSA, VA Hospitals, the Social Security Administration, Google, UC Berkeley, Catholic Healthcare West, White Plains School District, Cushman & Wakefield, and many others.
